Biographies

Tony Kushner Writer

Tony Kushner is a multi award-winning American playwright. His theatre work includes: La Fin de la Baleine: An Opera for the Apocalypse; A Bright Room Called Day; Yes, Yes, No, No; Stella; Slavs!; A Dybbuk, or, Between Two Worlds; an adaptation of S. Ansky's Yiddish classic Der Dibek; Henry Box Brown or, The Mirror of Slavery; Homebody/Kabul; and The Intelligent Homosexual's Guide to Capitalism and Socialism with a Key to the Scriptures. His highly acclaimed Angels in America: A Gay Fantasia on National Themes is in two parts - Millennium Approaches (winning a Pulitzer Prize and a Tony Award for Best Play) and Perestroika (also winning a Tony Award for Best Play). He wrote the book for the musical Caroline, or Change (1999).

Roger Haines Director

Roger is an established theatre director who has directed many award-winning productions for regional theatres, national tours and in the West End.

Notable productions include Sondheim's Into The Woods, Assassins (Manchester Library Theatre); the European premiere of William Finn's March Of The Falsettos (West End); Driving Miss Daisy (national tour); Laughter on the 23rd Floor (West End with Gene Wilder, nominated for an Olivier Award, also national tour). Sophisticated Ladies (West End); Maltby and Shire's Closer Than Ever, and Baby (national tours). Latterly he directed Calendar Girls and The Full Monty (national tours); and the world premier of The Girls by Gary Barlow and Tim Firth.

Recently he revived his award-winning production of *The Go-Between* (adapted by Richard Taylor and David Wood) in the West End starring Michael Crawford.

He is also developing the new musical *The Guinea Pig Club*, and is about to direct the national tour of comedian Tom Walker as *Jonathan Pie*.

Roger has also worked as a composer and a musical supervisor, and is a regular visiting director and mentor at various drama schools.

Kathleen Hefferon Associate Director

Kathleen is a director and theatre maker originally from New York City who is currently training in MFA Theatre Directing at Birkbeck, University of London. They attended New York University's Gallatin School for Individualized Study for her undergraduate degree, and upon graduating worked at various NYC institutions in roles varying from Assistant Director to Assistant Stage Manager; Props Manager to Script Supervisor (The Public Theater, Cherry Lane Theater, Jujamcyn Theatres, The Directors Company, Theatre for a New Audience, to name a few). In 2018 they started their own theatre company - Cardboard Classics Theatre. Recently Kathleen was Associate Director on Sticks and Stones at RADA is thrilled to be back working on Angels in America Part One: Millennium Approaches.

Abigail Sage Lighting Designer

Abigail Sage (Lighting Designer) is in her third year of the BA (Hons) in Technical Theatre and Stage Management specialising in lighting. Previous productions at RADA include *Gaslight* (Gielgud Theatre) and *Love and Information* (GBS Theatre). She is thrilled to be a part of this incredible team.

Kacey Thurbon is currently in her final year at RADA on the BA (Hons) in Technical theatre and Stage Management, specializing in sound design. 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
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
