Biographies

R.C. Sherriff

Writer

Robert Cedric Sherriff was born in 1896 in Middlesex. He served as an officer in the 9th Battalion of the East Surry Regiment during the First World War. He was wounded at Passchendaele in 1917. He wrote many plays with Journey's End being the best known. He was also a successful novelist and screenwriter receiving an Academy Award nomination for the adapted screenplay of Goodbye, Mr. Chips and BAFTA nominations for The Dam Busters and The Night My Number Came Up. Other screenwriting credits include The Four Feathers and That Hamilton Woman.

Gari Jones Director

Gari is a director, writer and maker with over thirty years experience and has worked in a vast range of environments and situations, from events in car parks and squat venues, to working in established theatres such as the National, Almeida, in the West End, as well as internationally including India, Mexico and Finland. He has directed a large number of classical and contemporary plays, worked with new and established writers and written a number of his own plays. Previous RADA productions include Caucasian Chalk Circle; The Trial; Dusa, Fish, Stas and Vi; Smelling A Rat; Splendour; Gaslight; Shook; and The Effect.

Miriam Dheva-Aksorn Designer

Miriam Dheva-Aksorn is a graduating student from the BA (Hons) Technical Theatre and Stage Management course at RADA, specialising in Set and Costume Design. Her most recent work includes designing *Journey's End*, directed by Gari Jones, and *Gundog*, directed by Joan Oliver, both produced at RADA.

Prior to training at RADA, Miriam studied Design and Architecture at Chulalongkorn University, where she designed and directed projects for Bangkok Design Week and TEDx. Her credits at RADA include Designer for *Picnic at Hanging Rock* (dir. Joshua Roche), Costume Supervisor for *Is God Is* and *The Cherry Orchard* (dir. Ebenezer Bamgboye), as well as work as Dresser and Scenic Art Assistant on *The Effect* (dir. Gari Jones).

Miriam is passionate about crafting visual narratives that connect text, space, and character. She continues to refine her practice in both set and costume design.

Deanna H Choi Sound Designer

Deanna H. Choi (she/her) composes music and designs sonic environments for stage, screen, and multimedia. She is fascinated by the interaction of sound, neurochemistry, architecture, and the impact of live performance on human behaviour. She has designed over 150 productions across Canada, the US, and the UK, and her film/television scores range from nature documentaries to scifi thrillers. Recent stage credits include *Beegu* (Unicorn Theatre); *The Tempest* (Jamie Lloyd; assistant sound designer); The Seagull (Barbican/ Wessex Grove; assistant sound designer); East is South (Hampstead Theatre; associate sound designer), and Toto Kerblammo (Unicorn; associate sound designer). She has won the Pauline McGibbon Award and two Dora Awards, and she teaches at the National Theatre School of Canada. Her sold-out cabaret show co-created and performed with Maddie Bautista, Love You Wrong *Time*, is currently on tour. www.splitbrainsound.com
