Diana Son is an American playwright, television producer and writer. Stop Kiss (GLAAD Media Award for Best New York Production) and Satellites are her two full-length plays, however she has written many short plays including Blind Date, The Moon Please, Siberia, BOY, 2000 Miles and Wrecked on Brecht. Her television work has included Law & Order: True Crime - The Menendez Murders, American Crime, Blue Bloods, Southland, Law & Order: Criminal Intent and The West Wing.

Stella Kammel Director

Stella Kammel is a director and writer for theatre, radio, and film. She directed her stage plays *Sonnet 61: Short People* and *Portrait* which were produced at the RADA Festival and Theatre N16.

Additional writing credits include: Sketching Dragons (short film, RADA); This Weird Normal (radio series co-written by Susan Wokoma and Asif Kahn, RADA); Sky Temp (radio, Audio Marvels); Surface Tensions (radio, Dagaz Media); Out and Around (theatre reading, RADA); 4 Cherry Drive (radio, RADA); Sleeping In (radio, University of Westminster); Afternoon Delight (radio, RADA), Cavities (radio, RADA).

Additional directing credits include: *Out and Around* (Gielgud Theatre, RADA); *The Importance of Being Earnest* (The Dalton School); *The Sandbox* (The Dalton School); *Salutations* (The Dalton School).

Dramaturgy credits include: One Night of Joseph Kaufman by Dmitry Glukhovsky, produced by Belka Productions, performed as a staged reading at the Vaudeville Theatre; and Disulfanide a radio play supported by the Royal Society of Chemistry and produced by Ignite and the Royal Welsh College of Music.

As a graduate of the BA Acting course at RADA, it is a pleasure to return as a director to work with RADA actors on this powerful and tender play.

Sophie Firth Designer

This is Sophie's second design at RADA and she is very excited. She is in her third year on the BA (Hons) in Technical Theatre and Stage Management, specialising in scenic art and design. Her previous credits at RADA include scenic art head of department on *King Lear* (Shakespeare for young audiences) and *Red Velvet*, as well as set and costume designer on *Consent* (dir. Jasmine Teo).

Alex Forey Lighting Designer

Alex is a third year student at RADA on the BA (Hons) in Technical Theatre and Stage Management specialising in lighting design. Previously he studied at University College London before switching to drama full-time. He has been awarded the Vectorworks Entertainment Scholarship 2020, and two UCL Design Awards. His designs at RADA include: *Monster* (Gielgud Theatre), *Graduate Tree* (Vanbrugh Theatre), Manifestos (RADA Studios).

As associate lighting designer: *Quintessential* (Peacock Theatre, Sadler's Wells), *Legally Blonde*, *The Drowsy Chaperone*, *RENT*, *The Pajama Game* (Pleasance), *Modern Love* (Etcetera Theatre).

As assistant/relighter: *Growl* (Theatre Royal Bury St Edmunds, Curve Leicester, Rose Kingston), as assistant: *Parade*, *Legend Trippers*, *Anything Goes* (The Other Palace).

In between designs, Alex has also worked as a technician for Ammonite (*Back To The Future The Musical*, *The Mirror and the Light*), Wyndham's Theatre, Shakespeare's Globe, the Donmar Warehouse, and the Lyric Hammersmith.
