# Biographies

## Rona Munro Writer

Rona Munro is a Scottish writer for stage, screen, television and radio. Her extensive theatre work includes My Name is Lucy Barton, Scuttlers (performed at RADA in 2017), The James Plays (which won the Evening Standard Award and Writers' Guild of Great Britain Award for Best Play in 2014), Little Eagles, The Last Witch, Watership Down, Indian Boy, Women on the Verge of a T Junction and Iron. Her film work includes Ladybird, Ladybird, Oranges and Sunshine and Aimee & Jaguar. She is also well known for writing two episodes for Dr Who - Survival in 1989 and The Eaters of Light in 2017. Her radio work includes eleven dramas for Radio 4's Stanley Baxter Playhouse.

#### Ola Ince

Ola Ince is a director and dramaturg based in London. In 2012 she was the Boris Karloff Bursary recipient. In 2015 Ola became a BBC Performing Arts Fellow, Resident Associate Director at the Lyric Hammersmith Theatre and Red Women of the Year nominee. In 2016 she became the Genesis Future Director Award winner and Artistic Associate at Lyric Hammersmith and Theatre Royal Stratford East. In 2018 she won the h100 Theatre & Performance Award. In 2019 she was named one of the Elle list's '50 Game Changers of Now.' Ola has been an Artistic Associate at the Royal Court Theatre and one of three recipients of the 2020/2021 National Theatre Sir Peter Hall Bursary. She was named as one of The Stage 25 in January 2022: "theatremakers to watch out for in 2022 and beyond."

Ola has worked at a number of prestigious theatres such as: Royal Opera House, Donmar Warehouse, Young Vic, Royal Court, National Theatre, Lyric Hammersmith, Regent's Park Open Air Theatre, St Ann's Warehouse (Brooklyn New York) and Lunt-Fontane Theatre (Broadway).

## Adam Nee Designer

Adam is an international set and costume designer for theatre, ballet, musicals and opera productions. He trained at Central St. Martins College of Art and Design and Wimbledon College of Arts. He is currently undertaking his PhD at Goldsmiths University exploring scenographic developments in Prokofiev's opera *The Fiery Angel* and was

awarded the Noëlle Mann Scholarship for his studies in this area.

Recently, Adam has been designing musicals across Europe, *Ghost The Musical*, and *Flashdance* which are currently touring Germany, Austria and Switzerland and *Priscilla*, *Queen of the Desert* in Austria. Previously Adam has worked in Ballet, with Derek Deane, Artistic Director of Shanghai Ballet designing two of his productions in Shanghai, *Sleeping Beauty* and *La Dame aux Camelia's* which will open in Brisbane, Australia in 2023. Further, previous productions include *Richard III* (Shakespeare's Rose Theatre, Blenheim), *The Dinner Engagement* and *Jenufa* (both Cochrane Theatre, London).

Adam is currently designing costume for *Fack Ju Göhte* which opens in Vienna in January 2023.

## Chuma Emembolu Lighting Designer

Lighting Designer Chuma Emembolu trained with the Royal Shakespeare Company, under the tutelage of the Chief Electrician and Lighting Designer.

And has had numerous Offie commended productions including *Great* Expectations (2019), Macbeth the Musical (2019), For Black Boys Who Considered Suicide When The Hue Gets To Heavy (2021) as well as Offie nominated productions like I and the Village and The Good Dad and many more productions.

Other Lighting design credits include: A Midsummer Night's Dream, King Lear, The Tempest, Popcorn, Anthony and Cleopatra. Romeo and Juliet, Metamorphosis, Gift of the Gab, Tainted The Musical and many more.
